Snacks and drinks will be available for purchase in the foyer.

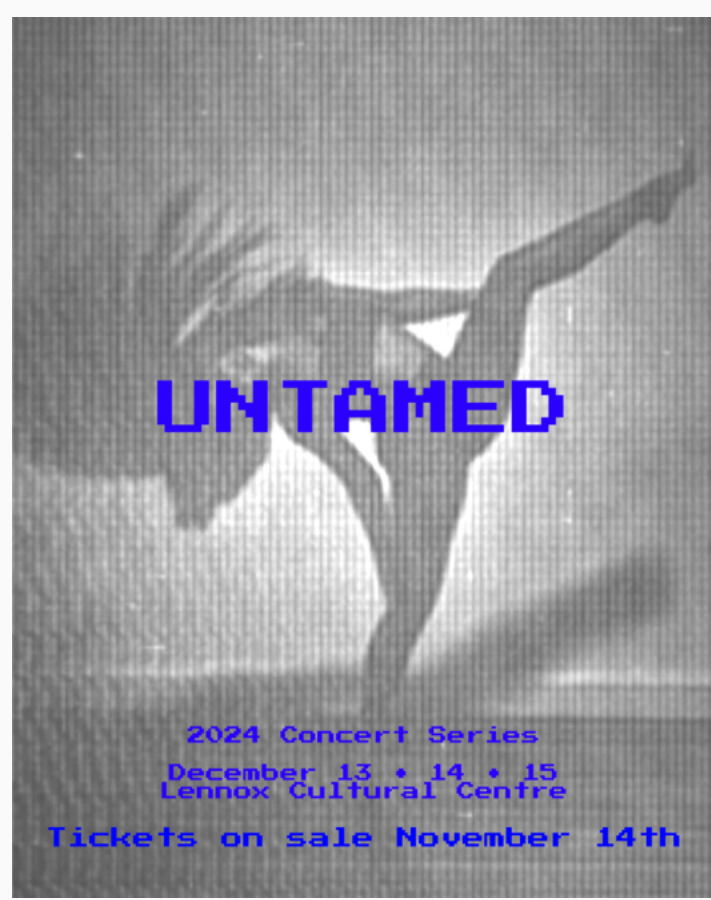
COSTUMES SHOES SOCKS

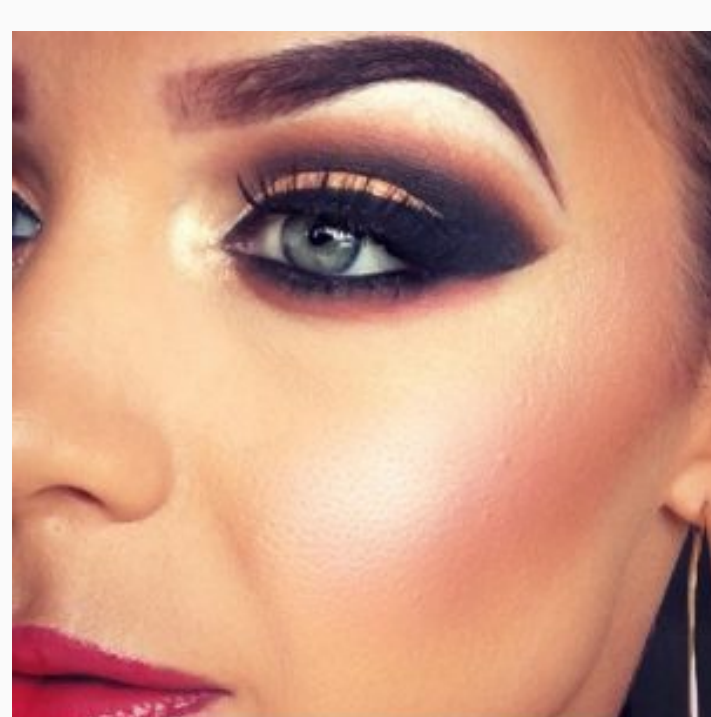

Dancers must arrive 30 minutes prior to show time, dressed in their first costume with hair and make-up completed and a Cape Tee, Tank or Jumper over the top.

STUDENTS PERFORM THE SAME SHOW ON BOTH DAYS AND ALL STUDENTS ARE ASKED TO STAY UNTIL THE END OF THE SHOW ON SUNDAY SO THAT THEY CAN PERFORM IN THE FINALE.

Any students watching the show must come backstage at least 2 routines before the finale to prepare. A short presentation will follow our Finale.

'UNTAMED' will run for approximately 2.5 hours plus a short interval. Snacks and drinks will be available for purchase in the foyer.



HAIR & MAKE UP

Full STAGE Make up is required for the concert. A base of foundation, rouged cheeks, brown eyeshadows, eyeliner, mascara and RED lipstick.

Parents should practice the hairstyle before the concert, to ensure that it is secure and will hold for the entire show. Please bring pins, hairspray and gel on the day of the concert so hair can be tidied between routines. Hairnets must be worn over buns. No Donuts!

Pre Juniors, Juniors, Grade 1, 2, 3, 4 Ballet
Mid figure 8 with a middle part.

Start with 2 ponies at the crown of the head, plait the ponies then pin them across the head to the other, hiding any wispy bits.

Pre Teen, Teen and Seniors, Grade 5, Intermediate F and above.

Middle part low/medium pony with plait. Students will then need to pin the plait into a bun for Ballet.



COSTUMES, TIGHTS, SHOES

Costumes will be distributed throughout the remainder of the term, right up until our tech rehearsal. All costumes will also come with further details and instructions.

Students should arrive for both shows dressed in their first costume with hair and make-up completed. They must wear a Cape Tee, Tank OR Jumper over the top of their costume. All other costumes should be hung in a suit bag ready to place in the dressing rooms.

PLEASE NOTE: BRING your CAPE Tee, Tee, Crop or Jumper and black dance shorts to dance in for the finale.

TIGHTS
All Jazz and Ballet students will need tights for the concert. Please purchase from Loretta from Cape Dancewear. Opening hours 12-5 Monday-Thursday, Friday 3:30-5:30, Saturday 9-11:30.

SHOES
You will receive a checklist with each costume. Please check you have the correct footwear for each dance. Shoes are also available to purchase at Cape Dancewear.

HIP HOP
All Hip Hop groups are required to wear plain white runners. Please ensure they are SPARKLING CLEAN! There are lots of cheap options at the stores below.
